REGISTRATION PROCESS

Summer Camp sessions are available to elementary students who attend the listed schools: Edison, Franklin, Mt. View, Riley, Washington, Bennion, Jackson, and Parkview Elementary camps are for **incoming 1st - 5th graders.**

Camp attendance numbers are determined on staff to student ratio and space limitations. Registration is on a first come, first served basis. Enrollment is limited to 65 students per session.

You must apply and pay in person at the school you are attending. Payment and forms are received by the Site After School Coordinator. Registration begins on April 2nd and continues until the camp is full. Coordinators are typically available at school sites from 12pm - 5:30 pm. For your convenience, camp registration documents are available on-line for parents to print or can be obtained at the school.

PAYMENT

Payment for camp session(s) are due at the time of registration. We offer several options to pay for your child's camp experience personal check, money order, or cash. NON-PAYMENT

Community Education does not bill camp fees.

There are no fee reductions for late arrivals or early departures. In the case of homesickness, dismissal, or voluntary withdrawal, there is no refund of fees and registration.
