

- Tier 2: Some Students-Individual & Small group counseling (friendship, voices, anxiety, Skills Group). Check-In/Check-Out (CICO) System.
- Tier 3: Few Students- Referrals to community resources, Individual Therapy, Individualized Plans, CICO
